



LEX Global Leaders Scholarship

The LEX Global Leaders Scholarship aims to promote international understanding by assisting those who would not otherwise be able to participate in a life-changing opportunity on a LEX exchange program or overseas internship. This scholarship honors the memory of wise and compassionate leaders in the LEX community.

Scholarships are to be used on exchange programs and internships organized by LEX Language Project to travel overseas from the United States and Canada. Applicants may be LEX members, members of our partner organizations, or from the general public.

The minimum amount of the scholarship is \$200 and the maximum is \$2,500 or half of the program fees, whichever is less, per person. Please do not ask for more than you need - we would like as many people as possible to benefit from the scholarship. Availability and amount of the scholarship is based on availability of funds and approval of the Selection Committee.

LEX Language Project does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression or identity, age, national origin (ancestry), disability, marital status, sexual orientation, military status or any other characteristic protected by applicable federal, state or local law.

All decisions of the scholarship committee are final. Any scholarships must be used in the calendar year they were awarded. If the recipient withdraws or is dismissed from the program, funds must be returned to LEX. Individuals who have received a scholarship from LEX in the current or previous calendar years are not eligible to apply.

Scholarship Recipients are required to complete the following upon their return:

1. Newsletter article (100 word minimum) and 5 photos for LEX.
2. Presentation of your homestay experiences with at least 3 audiences (at LEX clubs, your 4-H club, religious community, school, other community organizations, etc.) Share videos of these presentations back to the LEX office.

Instructions

1. Complete Scholarship Application Form and Sign
2. Forward Your Application to a Non-familial Reference

Forward your scholarship application to a non-familial reference, such as a teacher or employer, and ask them to fill out the reference section and forward to the LEX office by email. **Make sure they are aware of the deadline.** If you are a member of LEX of a LEX partner organization such as States' 4-H, PIE, ERDT, PAX, MAH, etc., forward your scholarship application to your LEX fellow or a state or local coordinator in the relevant organization.

3. Meet Your Deadlines

Scholarship applications are due at the same time as your program application. Applicants will receive notification within two weeks.
